## Instructions For Notice By Publication

- 1. If you do not know the address or identity of the last person in possession of the property allegedly stolen or embezzled, you will need to notify that person by publication.
- 2. The Court Clerk will arrange to have the Notice published for you. There is a publication deposit charge of \$25.00. this fee is set by law (28 O.S. §156). If the publication costs are les than \$25.00 you will receive a refund of the unused portion of that amount.
- 3. In addition to the fee, you will be required to complete the publication form listed below.
- 4. After the legal notice is published, send a copy of the notice and the Affidavit of Publication for the Court Clerk and the District Attorney.
